## Health Care Pan Wash and Combi-Oven Detergent

### **Product Description:**

COMBI-DET is a clear, odourless, alkaline liquid detergent. It is a carefully balanced blend of low foaming cleansers, alkalis, and water softening agents and is readily miscible with water. Designed to prevent the build up of bio – film on the interior of sanitising equipment. By controlling bio – film build up we can reduce bacteria contamination.

COMBI - DET is a non-chlorinated product to be used for Medical items and Instruments as well as the cleaning of COMBI OVENS. COMBI – DET is compatible with plastic, stainless steel and other materials (not aluminium), which are normally subjected to machine washing.

#### **Application:**

COMBI-DET is suited to Hospitals, Convalescent Homes and Health Care Facilities as a Food Service and Pan Wash. COMBI-DET is manufactured specifically for use in disinfector washing machines and Combi-Ovens and MUST NOT be used for washing manually. It should be dispensed by means of an electronic or venturi detergent feeder, which gives absolute control over detergent usage, resulting in minimum operating costs. Machine Type:

- Washing Disinfectors
- Utensil Washer Disinfectors
- Bed Pan Flush / Sanitiser
- Combi-Ovens

COMBI - DET is alkaline and contact with skin and eyes should be avoided. If splashed, remove contaminated clothing and bathe affected areas thoroughly with water. If swallowed, give milk or water. DO NOT induce vomiting. Contact a doctor or Poisons Information Centre immediately. Packed in 4 x 5 litre cartons.
