Conditioner for Exhaust Scrubber Systems

Product Description:

EXTRACT is a buff coloured, mildly alkaline powder specifically formulated for the cleaning of carpets and upholstery using truck mounted or portable hot water extraction units.

1. HIGHLY BUFFERED - to return optimum pH level to ensure maximum cleaning yet be safe to use on all fibres.
2. SYNERGISTIC DETERGENT SYSTEM - a combination of mild but efficient nonionic and anionic detergents coupled with a safe solvent with high grease and oil solvency ensures effective removal of most soils.
3. OPTICAL BRIGHTENERS - Specially selected for use on commonly encountered carpet fibres to brighten all colours and fibres.
4. CORROSION INHIBITORS - incorporated to protect against corrosion of all types of metals.
5. ANTIFOAMING AGENTS - to ensure excessive foam is not generated in reservoir tanks.
6. REODORISER - to leave carpets and rooms smelling fresh and free of stale or musty odours.
7. READILY SOLUBLE - dissolves readily in warm or cold water to minimise mixing time.

Application:

FOR TRUCK MOUNTED UNITS

Make up a concentrated stock solution by dissolving 1 kg of EXTRACT to 25 ltrs of water. Adjust the solution control metre on the truck mount to suit the degree of soiling of the carpet being cleaned. FOR

PORTABLE HOT WATER EXTRACTION UNITS

Dissolve 75 gm to 100 gm of EXTRACT to 25 ltrs of water.

EXTRACT dissolves readily in both cold or warm water.
