Technical Bulletin Lenz

Concentrated Window and Glass Cleaner/Sanitiser

Product Description:

LENZ is a concentrated formulation specifically prepared for cleaning glass. LENZ is also an excellent general surface sanitiser.

LENZ quickly and thoroughly removes smears, smut, grubby finger marks and other soil deposits from windows and all glass surfaces without hazing or smearing.

LENZ should be applied by spraying onto the glass surface with a hand sprayer. Alternatively LENZ can be wiped over the glass surface to be cleaned with a lint-free cloth, and then polished to a sparkling clear surface with a dry cloth.

When spraying onto glass surface immediately wipe dry with a clean cloth or paper. LENZ has been found to be an excellent cleaner of poker machines.

Application:

The formulation is recommended to be used neat but if necessary can be broken own 50/50 with water. LENZ as a sanitiser is required to be mixed at a rate of 4 parts water to 1 part product.

METHOD OF USE FOR LENZ AS A SANITISER:

There are two distinct methods of use:

METHOD 1

This is by far the most popular method, probably because of its ease and the fact that no equipment is needed to perform it.

The procedure is to dilute LENZ with water, according to the severity of the cleaning operation to be performed.

Immerse a hand sponge in the solution, squeeze it gently, and then wipe sponge over the surface to be cleaned. A clean cloth or rag will suffice for this job, if a sponge is not readily available. No rubbing is necessary, wipe off soils with another clean cloth. On glossy surfaces give one extra wipe with a damp cloth. With heavy soils the LENZ should be allowed to remain several minutes before wiping off.

METHOD 2

Is by the spray on, wipe off process.

The procedure for this is to dilute LENZ with water in a special hand spray gun, which is available from Castle Chemicals. However, conventional spray equipment can be equally effectively used. Spray onto the surface to be cleaned and wipe off soils with a clean cloth. On glossy surfaces give one extra wipe with a damp cloth.

With heavy soils, the LENZ should be allowed to remain several minutes before wiping off. LENZ as a sanitiser is required to be mixed at a rate of 4 parts water to 1 part product.
