Pine Oil Based Cleaner Sanitiser

Product Description:

SUMMIT PINE is a highly concentrated pine oil cleaner re-odorant, used generally as a daily maintenance cleaner.

SUMMIT PINE is described as a "Quick Break Detergent" and has been tested to break within the 10 minute parameter.

Application:

SUMMIT PINE is used extensively in general cleaning of floors, walls, benches and all types of enclosed spaces in hotels, motels, hospitals, offices and institutions.

SUMMIT PINE is especially useful in toilets, change rooms and amenity blocks.

General Purpose Cleaning	- Use 50 mls SUMMIT PINE for each litre of water.
Heavy Duty Cleaning	- Use 75 - 100 mls per litre.
Floors	- Using bucket and mop apply liberally with frequent rinsing.

Surfaces may be squeegeed or simply left to dry.

Highly concentrated natural pine oil cleanser sanitiser. Pine Oil chief constituents are tertiary and secondary terpenes which acts as a disinfectant and odourant.

Multi purpose deodoriser/cleanser, which eliminates the necessity for numerous different products in store.
