- 4. Use a stiff bristle brush to loosen dirt and dust from interior fan units. Vacuum to remove lingering debris.
- 5. Sweep or vacuum freezer floor of any loose debris.
- 6. Using microfiber or other cleaning cloths, wipe down the interior of your walk-in freezer with ARTIC CLEAN. This cleaner is ready-to-use and melts ice build-up on freezer walls, shelving units and floors without freezing.
