Eucalyptus Oil

Natural Solvent Greasy Soil Spotter

Product Description:

EUCALYPTUS OIL is a natural fast acting, solvent spotter for heavy duty applications, where an oily or sticky stain or deposit is to be removed prior to laundry or carpet pre spraying or extracting.

EUCALYPTUS OIL may be used as a spotter and sticky spot remover such as tape deposits, glue and other tape residues.

The following stains will give a guide as to the types of products EUCALYPTUS OIL will remove: Tar, Shoe Polish, Ball Point Ink, Butter, Margarine, Floor Wax, Salad Oils, Hand Lotion, Band Aid, bandage and tape residues.

Application:

Apply EUCALYPTUS OIL onto a piece of white cloth or towelling and wipe onto soiled area. Keep turning towel to fresh area to keep solvent on the fibre and so that you can inspect the amount of stain that has transferred to the towel. DO NOT RUB the item or carpet; extract or sponge with mild detergent solution, then water.

NEVER SPRAY EUCALYPTUS OIL as it is a flammable solvent. NEVER SMOKE when using EUCALYPTUS OIL and if used in badly ventilated areas for prolonged periods use a protective mask.

1. Always use protective gloves when using EUCALYPTUS OIL, as it can dry the skin and promote cracking.
2. Avoid breathing the vapour and never smoke while using EUCALYPTUS OIL.
