Fruit Wax Remover

Product Description:

WAX OFF has been developed specifically for the food safe removal of wax deposits from fruit and vegetable handling and waxing equipment.

Application:

WAX OFF can be easily applied by soaking, sponging and through a pressure washer.

Leave solution of WAX OFF on belts and rollers overnight. This will soften heavy deposits.

Daily cleaning will reduce the level of wax buildup on packing equipment.

Dilution may vary depending on, type of wax used and amount of build up.

Soak Application	1:10 warm water
Sponge	1:10 warm water
Pressure Washer	1:20 cold water

Following application, and as long a contact time as practical, mechanical agitation (e.g. stiff brushing) will aid removal. Finally rinse equipment and plant well with fresh water prior to re-commissioning / use.
