Moisture Plus

Sorbolene Style Vitamin E Moisturising Cream

Product Description:

Protects the skin from dusts, oils and other irritants, as well as moisturising the skin.

Rich in natural moisturisers and with a protective barrier, Vitamin E blended with Evening Primrose Oil helps to lock in moisture deep within your skin so it continuously hydrates your skin all day. Helping to soften and smooth dry skin, reduce blemishes and increase skin elasticity.

Application:

Apply a light layer before commencing work. Rub well in until feel of cream disappears. Re apply after each wash up. Protective and emollient paraffin oils waxes, and skin conditioners in an oil in water emulsion. MOISTURE PLUS is free of any silicones or added colour. As water based product Moisture Plus does not compromise the barrier properties of latex gloves.

An oil in water emulsion, pH is between 5 and 6 to match that of the skin. Moisture Plus is not an anionic & therefore will not interfere with the residual antibacterial properties of chlorhexidine gluconate (CHG) on the skin.
