Matador

Alkaline Detergent Sanitiser

Product Description:

MATADOR is a clear green, concentrated alkaline detergent sanitiser formulated with high-performance soil-removing and antimicrobial agents. MATADOR is a proven quick-break detergent, tested and confirmed to break within 20 minutes.

Product Benefits:

MATADOR delivers powerful removal of heavy soils, performs effectively in hard or soft water, and rinses freely for a low-residue finish. Its concentrated, non-caustic formulation provides economical cleaning across a wide range of applications. MATADOR contains no caustic alkali, solvents or soap.

Application:

MATADOR is a versatile cleaner and sanitiser designed for routine maintenance and heavy-duty cleaning. Select the dilution according to the type and severity of the contamination, using the following recommendations.

Light Duty Cleaning -	1 part MATADOR: 60 - 80 parts water.
Medium Duty Cleaning -	1 part MATADOR: 30 - 40 parts water.
Heavy Duty Cleaning -	1 part MATADOR: 10 - 20 parts water.

Clean and Disinfect

Dilute 1 part MATADOR with 60 parts water. Apply by mop, cloth or suitable scrubbing equipment, ensuring complete surface coverage. Keep the surface visibly wet for 10 minutes, then remove the excess solution with a mop or cloth. No rinsing is required unless specified for the surface or application.

All Purpose Cleaner

Dilute 1 part MATADOR with 80 parts water. Mop or scrub the surface as required, then remove the soiled solution with a clean mop or cloth. No rinsing is required on non-food-contact surfaces.

Kitchen Floors

To kill germs and bacteria on kitchen floors, dilute 1 part MATADOR with 60 parts water. Apply by mop or suitable scrubbing equipment, ensuring complete surface coverage. Allow the surface to remain visibly wet for 10 minutes, then remove the excess solution with a mop or cloth. No rinsing is required.

Polished Floors

Dilute 1 part MATADOR with 80 parts water. Apply with a damp mop and allow to dry. No rinsing is required. Buff to a high shine.

Workshop Floors

Dilute 1 part MATADOR with 10 parts water. Apply by mop or suitable scrubbing equipment and agitate the surface thoroughly. Allow the solution to dwell for 5 minutes, keeping the surface wet and not allowing the solution to dry. Remove the soiled solution thoroughly with a clean mop or wet vacuum. No rinsing is required when all excess solution has been removed.

When used as directed, MATADOR is suitable for cleaning and sanitising where incidental food contact may occur. The raw materials and ingredients used in MATADOR meet one or more of the following criteria:

1. Are permitted for relevant use as processing aids under Standard 1.3.3 and Schedule 18 of the Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code; or
2. Are Generally Recognised as Safe (GRAS) under U.S. Food and Drug Administration requirements or are listed under 21 CFR Part 178 for indirect food-contact applications.
